As summer is just around the corner and the holiday and festival season about to kick off, we thought we would share with you this amazing little gadget, the powermonkey-eXplorer (which we were most surprised that none of our friends or family knew about.)

This useful little gadget has helped us here at The Radiant Hand no end, and with the busy and hectic lifestyles that you all live, we think you will be inspired by it.. Every year as most of you know The Team at The Radiant Hand take time off to go on retreat. As well as having some well-earned R&R, we are continually dedicated to finding new locations for our retreats and other inspiring products.



On our last trip, we travelled the globe from Mexico to Nepal, and with the limited luggage allowance that airlines now provide, having a big bag of cables for all our work items (like phones, MP3 players, handheld games consoles and laptops), was not only a nuisance with all the wires, but took up valuable luggage space.

That's when we came across the powermonkey-eXplorer; whoever invented this was truly inspired. This wicked little gadget is a portable charger, and proved to be an invaluable bit of kit for our global expedition. Not only did it provide essential power for us from the beaches of Tulum in Mexico, to the remotest regions of Nepal in the Annapurna Himalayan range, but, because this portable charger also incorporates a solar-panel, which allowed us to charge whenever and wherever, Brilliant! Free power!

The solar panel draws power from the sun and converts it into handy power! The kit also included a useful Velcro strap, which allowed us to attach the solar panel on our rucksacks to charge whilst we were out and about in the sun. You can even hang it from a window, leave in a car or take it anywhere the sun shines!

It can be charged in three ways, via the solar charger, universal mains charger or via USB, keep it on hand for when your favourite gadget needs a power boost. It holds enough power to recharge a mobile phone up to three times, gives an iPod an additional 40 hours of playtime, or gives PSP/DS fans an additional 5 hours of game time.

Ultra compact, tough, powerful and iPod approved, the Powermonkey-eXplorer is water resistant and made from rubberised casing so it can take whatever life throws at it. It remains a light and most versatile portable charger so you can have it by the pool or on the beach charging your iPod.

So inspired by it that our own Director, Stephan, went and got himself a Powergorilla and used them both whilst he was living in the mountains of Bhutan last year. The Radiant Hand Team use them on the go whilst we are out and about in London or at a festival like Glastonbury or Bestival, where we might need a bit of free power.

The products at Powertraveller give us a lot of inspiration during a time when recycling and using new forms of eco or sustainable power should be at the top of our thoughts; it ties in beautifully with the concept of 'ahimsa' and our relationship with our environment. Please give a thought to this as every little change helps our environment and our planet Mother Earth, remember small droplets create big waves.
